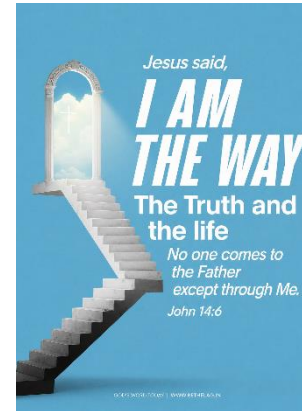

WEEKLY REFLECTION

**Let not your hearts be troubled...
I am The Way, The Truth and The Life**



In today's gospel, Jesus assures us "Let not your hearts be troubled...there are many rooms in my father's house...so that where I am you may be too." He further tells, He is The Way, The Truth and The Life. Jesus' passion in people's lives and His way of loving is also the way for us to live. Jesus is the way by which we travel to the fulness of God. Jesus is the truth.

He does not only speak the truth, but the fulness of truth is found in Him.

Jesus is the truth about God as He is truth about humanity.

As God, the Father looked to Jesus to reveal his true self, we look to Jesus to reveal the Father. He is the only true icon of God. Jesus is Life. We are because of Jesus. Our very life is his gift. Life is not an accident but a unique example of God's gift to us.

Was this explanation satisfactory to Jesus' disciples on the purpose of life? I don't think so. The disciples learned soon after Jesus left them, they did not have ready answers to everything. Looking to Jesus as the Way, the Truth and the Life doesn't solve every question we have about our life's purpose effortlessly.

MASS ETIQUETTE: A GUIDE TO REVERENCE

The Holy Mass is the greatest prayer we have.
Let us prepare our hearts and minds to encounter Christ
with faith, love, and reverence.

- 1. BEFORE MASS**
 -  **Arrive early.**
Give yourself time to prepare your heart and mind for Mass.
 -  **Dress reverently.**
Choose clothing that reflects the sacredness of the liturgy.
 -  **Move calmly.**
Enter the church quietly and prepare in silence and prayer.
- 2. CONDUCT**
 -  **Participate with attention.**
Listen, respond, and unite your heart to the prayers and worship.
 -  **Keep silence in the nave.**
Silence before Mass allows all to prepare and worship with one heart.
 -  **Do not leave early.**
Stay until the final blessing and dismissal out of respect for Christ and the community.
- 3. POSTURES**
 -  **Standing**
for the Gospel and the Creed as signs of respect and attention.
 -  **Sitting**
for the Readings and the Homily to listen and reflect.
 -  **Kneeling**
during the Eucharistic Prayer (in the US) as an expression of adoration.
- 4. COMMUNION**
 -  **Fast for one hour.**
Refrain from food and drink (water and medicine excepted) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion.
 -  **Bow before receiving.**
A bow signifies reverence for Christ truly present in the Eucharist.
 -  **Receive with deep reverence.**
Approach prayerfully, receive worthily, and respond "Amen" with faith and love.

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST



At the end of His earthly life Jesus ascends triumphantly into heaven. The Church acclaims Him in His holy humanity, invited to sit on the Father's right hand and to share His glory. But Christ's Ascension is the pledge of our own. Filled with an immense hope, the Church looks up towards her leader, who precedes her into the heavenly

home and takes her with Him in His own person: "for the Son of God, after incorporating in Himself those whom the devil's jealousy had banished from the earthly paradise, ascends again to His Father and takes them with Him" (St. Leo).

Jesus has entered heaven as our pioneer. He has blazed a trail. More, He is our representative; in a real way we are there with Him. The great work of reconciliation has been accomplished. The massive dam walls that human beings, through their wrong choices, had built up against the love of God have been demolished. We have only to stand in the way of these flood waters and not fly from them as though fleeing from death.

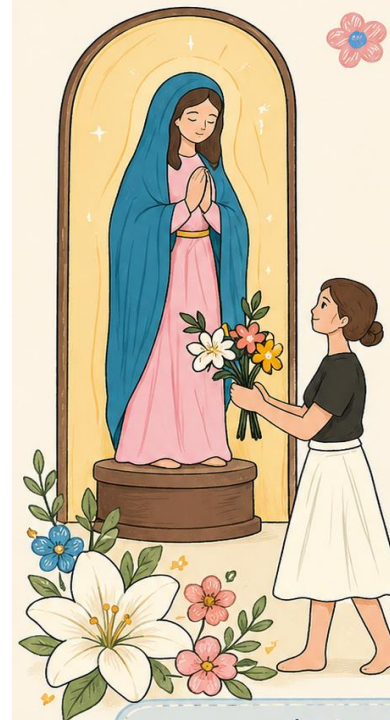
