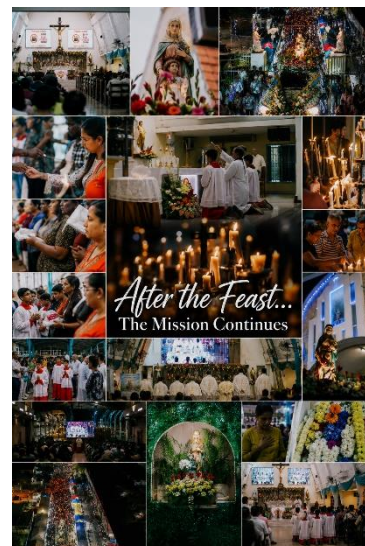

After the Feast... The Mission Continues

The joyful celebration of our Parish Feast has come to an end. The pilgrims have returned home, the tents have been dismantled, the lights have been taken down, and our parish returns to its familiar rhythm. Yet, the mission of the Church has not ended.



This Sunday's Gospel tells us that when Jesus saw the crowds, "His heart was moved with pity for them." Although He had sought a quiet place, He did not turn people away. Instead, He welcomed them, healed them, and fed them. More importantly, He challenged His disciples with these simple but powerful words: "Give them some food yourselves."

During our Feast, many parishioners answered that call. Through countless acts of service—whether welcoming pilgrims, preparing meals, singing in the choir, serving in ministries, ensuring safety, cleaning the grounds, or quietly working behind the scenes—you became Christ's hands and feet to thousands who came seeking hope, prayer and peace.

Now that the Feast is over, Jesus speaks the same words to each of us once again.

Our mission is not limited to ten days in July. It continues in our homes, our workplaces, our Basic Ecclesial Communities, and in every encounter with those who are lonely, discouraged or searching for God's love.

As we return to Ordinary Time, let us not return to ordinary discipleship. May the spirit of service, unity and hospitality that marked our Feast continue to shape our parish throughout the year. Let us keep alive the message we proclaimed during our celebration: "Peace Be With You." May that peace begin in our hearts, be reflected in our families, and be shared generously with everyone we meet.
