WEEKLY REFLECTION

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord;
my spirit rejoices in God my Savior

Just as the Magnificat is a song that glorifies and exalts God, Mary wanted God to be great in the world, great in her life and present among us all. She was not afraid that God might be a “rival” in our life, that with his greatness he might encroach on our freedom, our vital space. She knew that if God is great, we too are great.



Mary left no first relic of her physical body. But we honour the place where she was buried and just like her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, the tomb is empty. There is no body because as the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches: "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death."

But the Glorification of Mary's body and her Assumption was not by her own power, however. It was by the decision and act of God. So, to deny that it is impossible for Mary to be assumed into heaven both body and soul, is a direct affront to the sovereignty and power of God - to assert that God is powerless to do so.

At the end of Mary's life on earth, Mary is taken up to heaven in body and soul. She, who never knew sin, was assumed into heaven and never experienced corruption. Mary, as the new Eve, fulfilled God's plan from the beginning of creation. Mary always lived perfectly in the will of God. The handmaid of the Lord has laid down for us the perfect model of discipleship that we may follow. We are called to live in the will of God and we don't have to do this alone. She is there to help us.

THE FOUR MARIAN DOGMAS



1. Her Divine Motherhood

Early Church: Upheld by the Council of Ephesus in 431 A.D.

Mary is properly called the Mother of God (*Theotokos*) because her son, Jesus Christ, is both true God and true Man. Never did Christ give up any of His two natures since His Incarnation.



2. Her Perpetual Virginity

Early Church: Upheld by the Church Fathers

The Incarnation of Jesus did not spoil the virginity of Mary. God preserved her virginity before (*ante partum*), during (*in partum*), and after (*post partum*) the birth of Christ. She remained a virgin for life.



3. Her Immaculate Conception

Early Church: Formally defined by Pope Pius IX in 1854

In Mary, God prepared a dwelling place for the Incarnation of Jesus. At the first moment of her conception in the womb of her mother, St. Anne, Mary was preserved free from all stain of original sin.



4. Her Assumption, Body & Soul

Early Church: Formally defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950

Mary, being the Immaculate, ever-virgin Mother of God, after finishing the course of her life on earth, was taken up body and soul to heaven. Free from the stain of original sin, her body was not subject to decay.
