God was Reconciling the World to Himself in Christ and entrusting to us the Message of Reconciliation.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

**Do not look on him as an enemy,
but warn him as a brother"**

(2 Thessalonians 3:14).



Our Lord in today's Gospel passage lays down clear steps in engaging in fraternal correction. First, we do it privately instead of publicly. Second, if a private meeting fails to resolve the issue, bring in others for mediation. Lastly, if this still does not work, submit it to the adjudication of the community.

When even this last step of reasoning and conciliation fails, that person should be treated like "a pagan or a tax collector." Many would construe this as a command to excommunicate the person. But let us consider how our Lord dealt with the pagans and tax collectors. He came to bring the gospel to them, heal them, reconcile and save them.

It is important to note that the Lord refers to the person as "your brother." This highlights the fact that admonition is best done in the context of an established relationship. A person is much more likely to listen to a trusted friend or relative.

Saint Paul echoes these words when he writes, Do not look on him as an enemy, but warn him as a brother" (2 Thessalonians 3:14). St Paul is reminding us that we need to look upon someone you admonish as a "brother" and not an "enemy." Sometimes it is easy to see certain sinners inside and outside the Church as "enemies" and we make it our mission to "correct" them. We do not embark on our mission in a spirit of fraternal charity, but we do so as if we were going to war.

To admonish the sinner is not to belittle or humiliate the person, but rather to alert him to the danger of a sinful course of action. It is rooted in love, not pride.

So remember, to admonish the sinner begins by admonishing oneself. After all, we are all sinners. Humility is the virtue by which we recognise our sinfulness and our weakness, thus realising that we ourselves depend upon God's mercy to forgive us our sins and upon His grace to strengthen us to resist sin in the future.

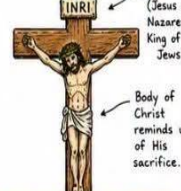
TYPES OF CATHOLIC CROSSES

① **LATIN CROSS**



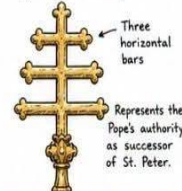
The most common Christian cross. Symbolizes the Crucifixion of Jesus Christ.

② **CRUCIFIX**



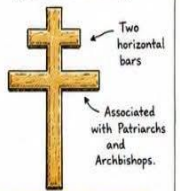
A cross with the body of Jesus. Used in Churches and homes for devotion.

③ **PAPAL CROSS (TRIPLE CROSS)**



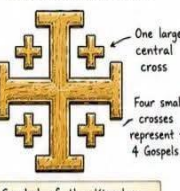
Used in the coat of arms of the Papacy. Top bar recalls the title INRI.

④ **PATRIARCHAL CROSS (DOUBLE CROSS)**



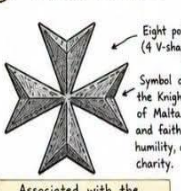
Symbol of authority in some Archdioceses and Catholic tradition.

⑤ **JERUSALEM CROSS**



Symbol of the Kingdom of Jerusalem and the five wounds of Christ.

⑥ **MALTESE CROSS**



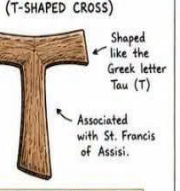
Associated with the Knights Hospitaller and protection of the faith.

⑦ **CELTIC CROSS**



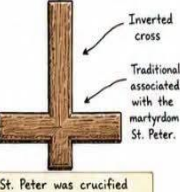
Common in Ireland and Celtic Christian tradition.

⑧ **TAU CROSS (T-SHAPED CROSS)**



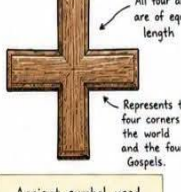
Symbol of humility and dedication to God's will.

⑨ **ST. PETER'S CROSS (INVERTED CROSS)**



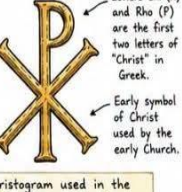
St. Peter was crucified upside down as he felt unworthy to die like Jesus.

⑩ **GREEK CROSS**



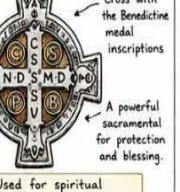
Ancient symbol used in early Christianity and church art.

Christogram used in the catacombs and baptized on early Christian artifacts.

⑫ **CROSS OF ST. BENEDICT**



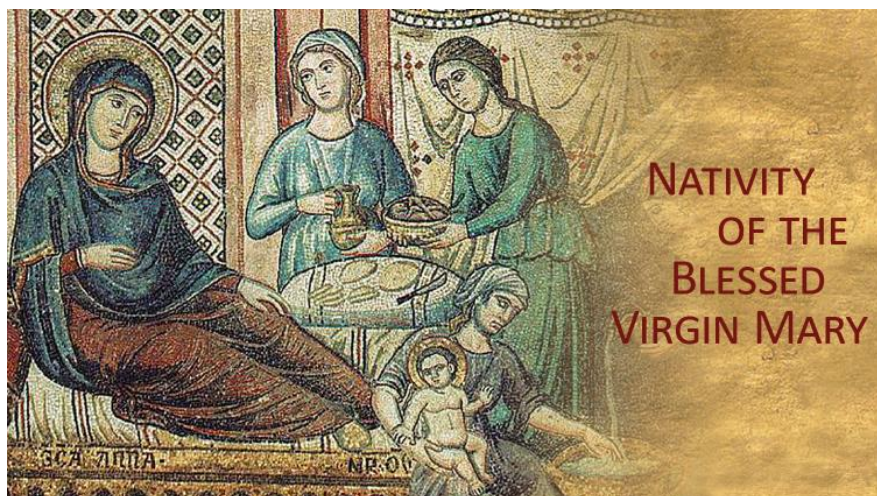
Used for spiritual protection and invoking the intercession of St. Benedict.

Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary



This is one of the most ancient Marian feasts. It is thought that this feast originated in connection with the Feast of the dedication of a church dedicated to Mary, now the Church of St Ann, in Jerusalem in the 6th century. Tradition holds that this is where the house of Mary's parents, Joachim and Ann, stood and where she would have been born.

The Feast began to be celebrated in Rome in the 8th century with Pope Sergius I. It is the third such feast of a "nativity" on the Roman Calendar: the Nativity of Jesus, the Son of God (Christmas); the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist (24 June); and the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8 September).

Nothing can be found in the Gospels to confirm this feast. They do not even give the names of her parents, which are based on a tradition that stems from the 2nd century Protoevangelium (apocryphal) Gospel of James. The primary event in Mary's life always remains the Annunciation.

The Church looks on her as the Mother of God, but even more so as the disciple who can best offer us an example and model of the Christian life. In her faith, in her obedience to her Son, in the way she made herself a neighbour toward her cousin Elizabeth and to the couple in Cana on their wedding day, Mary is the woman to imitate especially in the trust shown during the darkest moments in the life of Jesus, her Son. Here, and in many other moments, she explains why the people of God know they can find their refuge and comfort, help and protection in her.
